

UPDATE May 2021



From April 1st, 2019 – March 31st, 2020 Riding for Smiles, delivered around 80 sessions, 600 individual equestrian experiences.

From April 1st, 2020 – March 31st, 2021 these numbers dropped to 20 sessions, 210 individual equestrian experiences.

IN JUST 4 MONTHS from April 1st, 2021 – July 31st, 2021 RfS with CCEC will have delivered around 80 sessions, 600 individual equestrian experiences.

That represents a 300% growth in numbers from the pre-covid numbers.

There is absolutely no doubt that the benefits for the children and schools are being delivered and the need seems to be significantly increased.
