### **Real and lasting benefit continues to be delivered for every child.**

The amazing success would not be possible without the support of our staff, and the Coloured Cob Equestrian Centre. Without funding from the likes of The National Lottery Community Fund, Children in Need and many others RfS would not exist. Each child attends for a minimum of six weekly sessions up to a maximum of twenty-four weeks. RfS, together with schools, carefully assesses each child and we all work together to really make a difference for each and every child. Costs are high, somewhere between £150 and £600 for each child who comes along, we know every penny spent leads to real and lasting change. We believe RfS is different, RfS delivers and is unique in its dedicated and professional approach.

### **Disappointed**

Imagine how disappointed we were when Derbyshire County Council described RfS in these words regarding the Deprivation and ASL Programme. *"Value for money is limited"*.
